SYMPOSIUM PROCEEDINGS: Additionally, if you wish to be published in the Symposium Proceedings, you must remit the appropriate registration fee in full as well as the required documents by 29 April 2006. Visit www.igarss06.org and download the Author Instructions for details. Both oral and interactive presentations may be published in the Proceedings; however, publication is not required for presentation. Using the formatting instructions available on the website, you should submit an electronic file to the electronic publisher and forward all additional requirements as requested by the due date.

WITHDRAWALS: If you must withdraw from the program, please notify IEEE GRSS via email ieeegrss@adelphia.net as early as is possible. Early notification will allow the technical program committee an opportunity to fill your position with alternate presentations.

TRAVEL VISA: Foreigners wishing to enter the United States of America to attend IGARSS'06 should possess valid passports and valid entry visas if required. Any visitor from countries that have no diplomatic relations or no special visa exemption with the U.S.A. should obtain an entry visa before coming to the U.S.A.
